Divine Mercy Sunday

Sun. 7 April at 3 pm. We will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, followed by Benediction.

Divine Mercy Sunday Promises & Requirements

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, each time in a slightly different way:

"I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy." (1109)

"Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment." (300)

"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (699)

Thus to fittingly observe the Feast of Mercy, we should:

- 1. Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter;
- 2. sincerely repent of all our sins;
- 3. place our complete trust in Jesus;
- 4. go to Confession, preferably before that Sunday;
- 5. receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast;
- 6. venerate* the image of the Divine Mercy; and
- 7. be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.
- *To venerate a sacred image or statue simply means to perform some act or make some gesture of deep religious respect toward it because of the person whom it represents—in this case our Most Merciful Savior.
